JIGSAWEQUINE Journeys to World Cup Qualifier—Wits End Farm, Canada

The summer was a busy time for Jigsaw Equine: We completed the series of seminars called "Inside the Mind of a Winner". A series that included talks on How To Focus; Build Confidence; Handle Anxiety and Preparing to Compete.

So, as August arrived we set off on a new challenge! We decided to put ourselves to the test by practicing what we preach - preparing to compete on a large and rather daunting scale!

Canada, August 2009 was host to the HSBC sponsored World Cup Qualifier—a Three Day Event which is the penultimate round before the world cup in Poland.

For five days we witnessed the frenzy that beset a tranquil Farm as it transformed

into a World Cup Stage. It was nothing short of a Military Scale Operation!

Our time was spent 'up close and personal' with 'behind the scenes' stars who make such an event possible.

400 volunteers clad in red T-Shirts blanketed the 197 acres of land littered with Cross Country fences, Show Jumps, warm up and competition arenas. VIP Marquee, Hospitality Tents, Media and Trade Stands and of course 90 temporary stables and related facilities for riders and grooms.

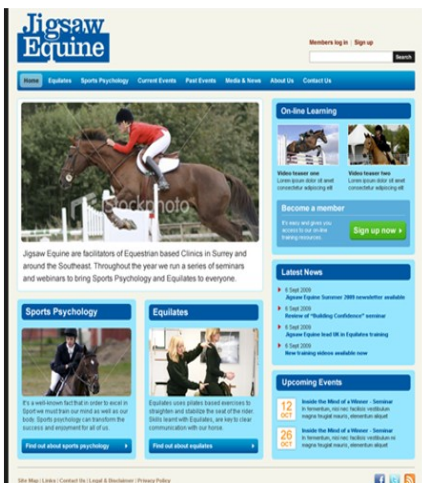

For five days we numbered and flagged course fences, 'titivated' jumps with plants (from the 2000 stock ordered for the event); we erected sponsor banners and tore about the place capturing 'on the job' interviews with FEI officials.
